



# Sidecar Assembly Manual

For reasons of safety and stability, parts number 1 and 2 are assembled during transport. Before you start building your Core Station , split the pieces. You will see 4 wooden dowels which hold together the two parts.




Remove the Wooden dowels and **do not use them for assembly**. You are now ready to start building your Core Station.



- Metal Hardware.








Rack Rail



- clean with a soft cloth, slightly humid or specific products for wood or lacquer; - avoid the use of abrasive cleaners.



The assembly of your desk uses special kits.


Here's how to use them

 On the piece with the threaded insert(s), put in the system bolt(s) and tighten making sure to align the hole in the system bolt at a 90° angle.



Please note that the system bolt may have a little slack in this position, which is fine!

2) Ensure that the hole in the bolt aligns with the opening in the other piece to be able to put in the safety screw.



 In each hole in the second piece, put in a cone shaped safety screw and tighten with a cross (philipps) screw driver - without forcing. The 2 parts will now be safely attached.
